ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORTS ON THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF EASTERN BUND WALL AT PULAU TEKONG AREA D

On 26 April 2005, Malaysia and Singapore signed a Settlement Agreement concerning land reclamation by Singapore in and around the Straits of Johor. The Settlement Agreement included the final design of the shoreline of the land reclamation at Pulau Tekong Area D.

HDB intends to commence construction of the eastern bund wall at Pulau Tekong Area D using a combination of three types of soil improvement methods as follows:

- (a) Trench and bund filling with Cement Stabilised Dredged Fill;
- (b) Soil improvement by Deep Cement Mixing and Sand Pile with sand bund construction; and
- (c) Soil improvement by Sand Pile with sand bund construction.

The impact of these methods of construction has been studied.
